## News About PLI Discover PLUS: The Mobile App Is Here!

We are thrilled to announce the launch of the PLI Discover PLUS app, which is available for [download now in the App Store!](#) The Discover PLUS app allows you to use your Discover PLUS account from your iPad or iPhone and have access to over 55,000 secondary source legal documents, all of which are written by experts in their respective fields. You can also download documents to your device so that you can view them when you're flying, on the train – anywhere you're offline! The app complements the web version of PLI Discover PLUS and provides the ability to search or browse our content; save documents; and highlight, bookmark, or take notes.

## PLI Discover PLUS Enhancements: Synchronization Between the App and the Desktop Experience

With the addition of the Discover PLUS app, you now have the ability to work offline and save your work. Simply select the documents you'll want to access, download them to your iPad or iPhone and easily view them while you're on the subway, on a plane, or anywhere else you're without an Internet connection. Start taking notes, highlighting text, adding bookmarks, or creating bookshelves and all of your work will automatically sync up with the desktop version once you're back online.

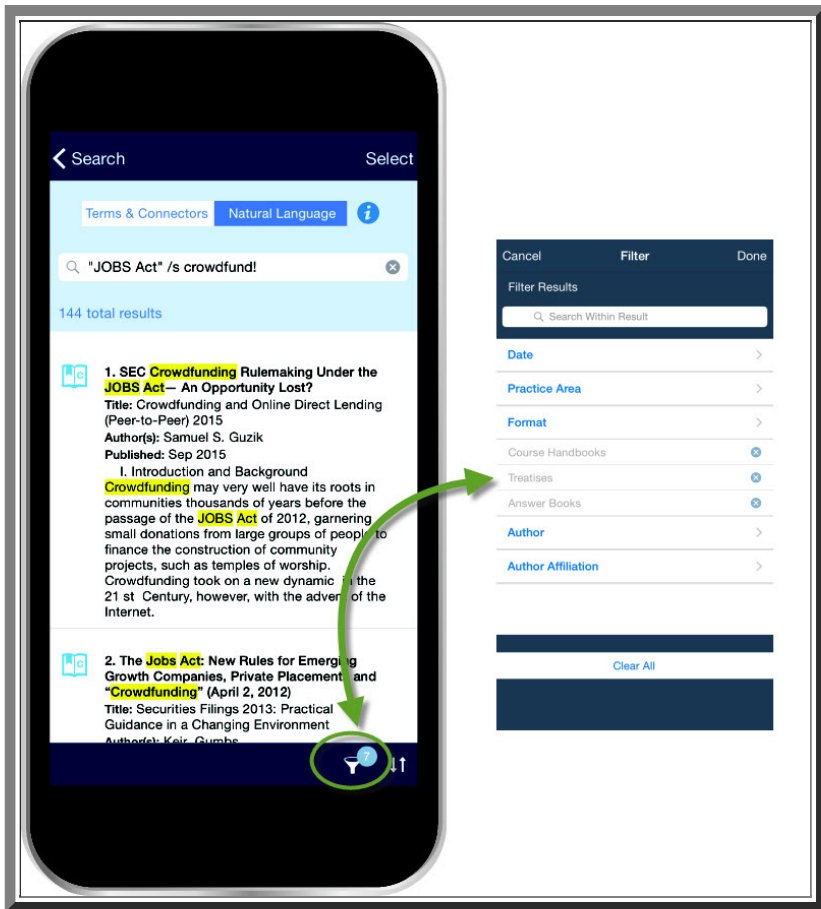
## PLI Discover PLUS Search Tips: Robust Searching on the Go

The app is primarily an eReader; however, we understand that powerful search functionality can help you find the relevant information you need quickly and easily. Whenever you have a connection, the app offers the same robust search capabilities as the web version, including terms and connectors searching and filters.

For example, if I want to learn more about how the JOBS Act is easing certain restrictions on crowdfunding, I can use the Discover PLUS app and do the following search on the go: "JOBS Act" /s crowdfund!

As you can see, this search includes an exact phrase, proximity, and a root expander – I'm looking for the phrase "JOBS Act" within the same sentence as various endings of the word, "crowdfund" (crowdfunded, crowdfunding, etc.).

This search generates 144 results, which you can then narrow down using the date, practice area, format, author, or author affiliation filters.
